In Patricia's own words in 1992: "I entered Loretto at the age of 15 in 1932. I came from a very loving, happy, caring family in the Loretto Family.... Christ and kids have been my total life commitment, and still are. I have always been a teacher — retired in 1990, but still subbing in Catholic and Public Schools. Loretto is very dear to me and always will be." Pat had two Loretto sister relatives — her aunt was Agnes Albin, and her first cousin is Pauline Albin.

After more than 34 years teaching in Loretto staffed schools in Missouri, Illinois, Alabama, Colorado, Texas, New Mexico, and California, Pat was dispensed from her vows in 1968 and became a co-member in 1981. Her own words at that time: "I love the Community and have grown-up in it. I want to keep in touch with all my dearly loved sisters. I want to keep abreast of all the changes and happenings in the Congregation."

By all accounts, Pat was an extraordinary teacher. She taught everything from first grade to college along the way. She spent many years as an art teacher in the Denver Public Schools. Besides teaching, she was a professional gift wrapper and designed and made clothes. She loved interior decorating.

Pat regularly renewed her co-member commitment and always said that her life was deeply rooted in Loretto, and that she wanted that connection to continue. And so it did. Pat lived her last retirement years in Denver at the Argyle — an assisted living home. Pat deeply appreciated the love of Loretto and the beauty in the world around her. God bless you, Pat!
